Business Support

Seven businesses contacted The Hub in August. One from Kincardine, Arran-Elderslie, and Owen Sound, and four from Huron-Kinloss. The Hub helped these businesses in the following areas:

- 1. Two private office rentals
- 2. Website design assistance
- 3. Agricultural business zoning requirements inquiry
- 4. Business re-branding and marketing
- 5. Starting a business
- 6. How to expand into and market speaking engagements and programs

Events

The Hub's monthly in person networking event was held on Thursday, August 25. The next networking event is Thursday, September 29 at 7:00pm, all are welcome to attend. At the September session, Carley Donaldson from Route Two Communication will discuss business communications.

Digital Main Street

Two new Digital Service Squad members joined the Bruce County team and will begin at the start of September. Sarah Taylor will cover the Northern Bruce and South Bruce Peninsula regions, and William LeGrand will cover the Brockton and South Bruce regions. The Bruce County Digital Service Squad team will assist businesses in applying for a \$2,500 Digital Transformation Grant and help them with their digital marketing until March 31, 2023.

- 3. The Do Business Facebook page reached 2,362 likes.
- 4. LinkedIn reached 73 followers.
