One of the programs funded by Bruce County is the YMCA Emergency Shelter Program, which has a priority of ensuring safety and access to basic needs. Anyone that is homeless or at risk of homelessness can contact a YMCA Housing Stability Worker who will assist in confirming a safe place to stay for the night and work with those in need of support to create an action plan to find and maintain long-term sustainable housing.
