Calls for Service of Note

Violent Crime

Assault – Three of the assaults were Domestic related. Two involved an individual at a Nursing Home with dementia – officers worked with the staff of the home to address. One was deemed a consensual fight between two males. Charges were laid in five of the reported occurrences.

Property Crime

Have Stolen Property – All these incidents were as a result of recovered stolen vehicles for which an accused was identified and charges laid.

Fraud – The majority of the frauds reported during this time period were conducted on-line. They ranged from an occurrence where an Instagram account was hacked and the owner threatened with exposing photo-shopped photos to fake Face Book marketplace ads to fake rental ads to the hacking of a computer and the owner sending money to the hacker.

Drug Crime

Warrant - On 09 June the Community Street Crimes Unit conducted a warrant in South Bruce Township. The warrant resulted in the recovery of 6 motor vehicles, 8 brand new kayaks still in the packaging, two ATVs, two dirt bikes, a Seadoo, a Skidoo, a utility trailer, a car trailer and a camper trailer. Also recovered were firearms, other weapons and drugs. The total value of the property recovered was approximately \$212,000.00 and the drugs were valued at \$25,000.00. Two suspects were later charged.

Traffic

- South Bruce OPP participated in the Canada Day Week traffic campaign that commenced June 25th and concluded on July 3rd. South Bruce officers laid:
 - > 178 Speeding Charges
 - > 2 Stunt Driving Charges
 - > 2 Seatbelt Related Charges
 - 2 Impaired Charges
- All members of the South Bruce Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) took part in the Civic Holiday Weekend safety initiative that ran from July 29, 2022, to August 1, 2022. The following charges were laid:
 - > 119 speeding charges
 - > 3 Stunt Driving Excessive Speed charges
 - > 2 motorists charged with Impaired Driving
- South Bruce OPP officers joined our Highway Safety Division officers on a Commercial Motor Vehicle blitz on Aug 3rd. They were also joined by a member of MTO.
 - > 19 Commercial Motor Vehicles were inspected
 - ➢ 6 were pulled from service
 - > 13 charges were laid
- 13 hours dedicated to Golf Car Focused Patrol 6 warnings and education provided, a number of community complaints received
- 15 hours of Foot Patrol conducted

Other Calls for Service

Music in the Fields – this event generated a number of calls for service for our officers throughout the weekend.

Five RIDE programs were held in a proactive effort to curb Impaired Driving. Over 1000 cars were checked at these RIDEs. Despite this, three individuals were arrested for Impaired Driving offences and four Liquor Licence Control Act charges were laid.

Four individuals were arrested for Public Intoxication with three of those being held in the cells overnight.

We responded to a Mischief complaint as well as a Cause Disturbance call.

- South Bruce OPP is happy to introduce a new recruit, PC Francois Van Jaarsveldt has recently joined the OPP. He is formerly from South Africa and successfully completed his recruit training and has now been posted to the South Bruce detachment.
