Background:

Ontario Regulation 407/21 Pilot Project – Golf Cars sets out the broad regulatory framework to allow golf cars on roads in Pelee Island and in Huron-Kinloss and includes operator and vehicle requirements. On August 16, 2021, Council approved participation in the 10-year Golf Car Pilot Project and passed By-Law No. 2021.

Discussion:

Registration sits at 59 new registrations and 20 renewal registrations for a total of 79 permits issued.

Comments and feedback on the pilot project are still being received by the Clerk's department and will be compiled and reported to the Ministry. Updates will continue to be provided to Council and the Police Services Board.

Communications regarding registering for the 2022 Golf Car pilot are ongoing. A social media campaign began in April and will run through to the fall. The South Bruce O.P.P. are also pushing out communications on the pilot project and have performed focused patrol specifically in the lakeshore area to increase education and enforcement on the project.
