This report provides an update of Emergency Management and Health and Safety activities.

Discussion:

Emergency Management

During September Special Event Permits were issued to Lucknow and Ripley Agriculture Societies for Fall Fairs.

Emergency Preparedness displays were set up at both events sharing public information on various emergency preparedness topics.

Health and Safety

Training: All new hires have completed orientation training.

Inspections: Regular monthly inspections were completed at Township facilities. Corrective actions have been discussed, action owners and due dates have been assigned with many items completed.

Incident: There were no incidents during this period.

Joint Health & Safety Committee (JHSC): The Township of Huron-Kinloss, Ripley Huron Fire Department and Lucknow District Fire Department committees attended September meetings.
