Background:

Huron Landfill Fence

The installation of a chain link fence along the north side of the Huron Landfill property was awarded to Royal Fence Inc. on May 16, 2022.

Kinloss Landfill

The Kinloss Landfill is open on Saturdays from 10am-2pm starting on the first Saturday in April until the last Saturday in October. The site accepts scrap metal, recycling, tires and brush.

Fall Leaf Collection

In November, the Township offers a one day leaf collection service in the areas of Lucknow, Ripley and the Lakeshore.

Discussion:Huron Landfill Fence

Construction of the fence along the north side of the property is now substantially complete with a few finishing tasks to be completed.

Kinloss Landfill

The Kinloss Landfill will be closing for the season on Oct. 29th this year.

Fall Leaf Collection

This year's events are scheduled for November 7th in Ripley and Lucknow and November 8th along the Lakeshore.

Financial Impacts:

The 2022 Capital Budget includes \$150,000 for the construction of the fence at the Huron Landfill. The fall leaf collection costs are included in the Operating Budget.
