Background:

Fire Department Administration

During the month of October, the following Fire and Emergency Services administrative tasks have been initiated, are on-going and/or have been completed.

1. All general administrative tasks with the day-to-day operations of the Fire Departments for the month have been completed.
2. The monthly activities for the Ripley-Huron and Lucknow & District Fire Departments are detailed below in the discussion section.
3. Fire Prevention Week Open Houses for each station conducted. Ripley-Huron attendance approx.. 100 people. Lucknow attendance approx. 175 people.
