Background:

The Ripley Minor Baseball and Ripley Minor Soccer programs provides opportunities for youth as they learn the fundamentals of soccer and baseball while encouraging safe physical activities for a variety of age groups and educating participants on the importance of a healthy lifestyle.

Discussion:

In 2022, Ripley Summer Sports had 181 youth between the ages of 4 and 13, register for baseball and soccer programs. Our hope is have the same or more register for another successful season in 2023.

Registration for the 2023 Minor Baseball and Minor Soccer programs opened December 1, 2023. In keeping our fees similar to our neighbouring communities while providing a quality program, and adding indoor spring clinics, the Summer Sports Committee is proposing an increase to the 2023 Summer Sports Registration fees as noted in attachment 2023 Ripley Summer Sports Registration Rates.
