This Memorial Ride, featuring 50 cyclists and 5 ambulances representing Paramedic Services from across Ontario, is traveling from Windsor to Tobermory on a four-day cycling trek (September 30 to October 3).

The Paramedic Ride is dedicated to strengthening the Paramedic community and commemorating those Paramedics who have lost their lives in the line-of-duty. Funds raised will support the Canadian Paramedic Memorial Foundation, Boots on the Ground, and Camp F.A.C.E.S (through the Canadian Critical Incident Stress Foundation).

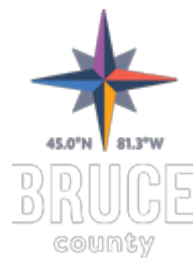
