BY-LAW

No. 2022 - 186

BEING A BY-LAW TO REPEAL CBO APPOINTMENT BY-LAW

WHEREAS Section 8(1) and 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provide that the powers of a municipality under this or any other Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues and has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purposes of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS Section 3(2) of the Building Code Act, S.O. 1992, c.23, requires that a Council of a municipality appoint a Chief Building Official and such inspectors as are necessary for the enforcement of the Act in areas in which the municipality has jurisdiction;

AND WHEREAS a vacancy has occurred in the position of Chief Building Officer;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss on December 19, 2005 passed By-law No. 2005-126 entering into a shared services agreement with the Municipality of Ashfield-Colborne-Wawanosh for the purpose of sharing services of the Chief Building Official;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss on November 19, 2012 passed By-law No. 2012-120 entering into a shared services agreement with the Municipality of South Bruce for the purpose of sharing services of the Chief Building Official;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss deems it advisable to repeal the appointment of a CBO for the Township of Huron-Kinloss due to a vacancy in that position;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss **ENACTS** as follows;

1. That By-law No. 99-158 and By-law No. 2017-139 are hereby repealed.
2. That this by-law shall come into full force and effect upon its final passage.
3. That this by-law may be cited as the "Repeal CBO appointment By-law".

READ a FIRST and SECOND TIME this 12th day of December, 2022.

READ a THIRD TIME and FINALLY PASSED this 12th day of December, 2022.
