

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Bruce County Council begins 2023 Budget Process

At the Thursday, January 12, 2023 Corporate Services Committee Meeting, Bruce County Council began the 2023 budget process by receiving a pre-budget presentation which included budget themes, an overview of the County's current financial position, and considerations for the 2024-2027 forecasted budget.

At the Thursday, January 12, 2023 Corporate Services Committee Meeting, Bruce County Council began the 2023 budget process by receiving a pre-budget presentation which included budget themes, an overview of the County's current financial position, and considerations for the 2024-2027 forecasted budget.

With the 2023 budget, Bruce County intends to strengthen the foundation of core services by changing course towards fiscal sustainability, being resilient to change, building reserves, and becoming the employer of choice in Bruce County by attracting and retaining a skilled workforce.

The 2023 draft budget package will be presented at the Thursday, January 19, 2023 Corporate Services Committee Meeting.

Bruce County Council will carry budget review, discussion, and direction into February with the potential for budget approval and adoption in February or March. While Council will receive a 2023-2027 draft budget package, they will only be approving the 2023 budget. Forecasted numbers can be amended in future budget discussions.

Budget pressures for 2023 include inflation being close to 7% and construction price inflation at 14% for 2022, some federal and provincial funding not keeping up with inflation, the desire to improve our net financial asset position, and the desire to eliminate the annual infrastructure deficit over 15 years.

Warden Chris Peabody commented, "Bruce County Council is eager to review the 2023 draft budget at the next Corporate Services Committee meeting in January. We are looking for opportunities to meet the needs of our residents, while also encouraging economic recovery and planning for the future. We will continue to pursue quality infrastructure upgrades and support-services in Bruce County. I would like to thank our staff for their hard work on building the draft budget."

According to Director of Corporate Services Edward Henley, "County staff are creating a responsible draft budget that reflects Council's strategic direction and the challenges of our current times. We look forward to continuing on a fiscally responsible path."

At the Thursday, January 19, 2023 Corporate Services Committee Meeting, Bruce County Council has tabled the draft 2023-2027 Capital and Operating Budget for review. The proposed budget illustrates 2023 inflationary pressures, the desire to improve our net financial asset position, and the desire to eliminate the annual infrastructure deficit over 15 years.

With this 2023 budget, Bruce County intends to strengthen the foundation of core services by changing course towards fiscal sustainability, being resilient to change, building reserves, and becoming the employer of choice in Bruce County by attracting and retaining a skilled workforce.

Proposed Capital spending in 2023 will increase from \$10.2M to \$12.2M. The proposed Operating budget will see an increase

from \$46.3M to \$51.6M. The County is making key investments in Paramedic Services, Long Term Care, Infrastructure, and Housing Facilities.

Bruce County Council will carry budget review, discussion, and direction into February with the potential for budget approval and adoption in February or March. While Council has received a 2023-2027 draft budget package, they will only be approving the 2023 budget. Forecasted numbers can be amended in future budget discussions.

Warden Chris Peabody commented, "Bruce County Council will review this 2023 draft budget over the next few weeks. Infrastructure upgrades and support services continue to be key priorities for Bruce County and are strongly reflected in this draft budget. Council will look for opportunities to continue the County down a fiscally responsible path while also encouraging economic recovery. Thank you to County staff for the hard work and prudent planning that went into building this draft budget."

On Monday, January 23, 2023, Bruce County's Director of Human Services, Christine MacDonald, participated as a member of a concurrent panel on housing affordability and development at the 2023 Rural Ontario Municipal Association (ROMA) Conference in Toronto.

In the session, called "Attracting Housing Development to Rural Ontario", Director MacDonald shared creative approaches to addressing the impacts of Ontario's housing affordability and availability challenges and providing the full spectrum of housing options, particularly rental accommodations, for residents regardless of income or stage in life.

Director MacDonald highlighted the need for greater direct engagement by the municipal sector with the non-profit and private development sectors and explored approaches and tools to attract housing development, which is often a challenge for rural communities. Bruce County's Affordable Housing Toolkit was showcased as a key strategy in the County's Housing and Homelessness Plan.
