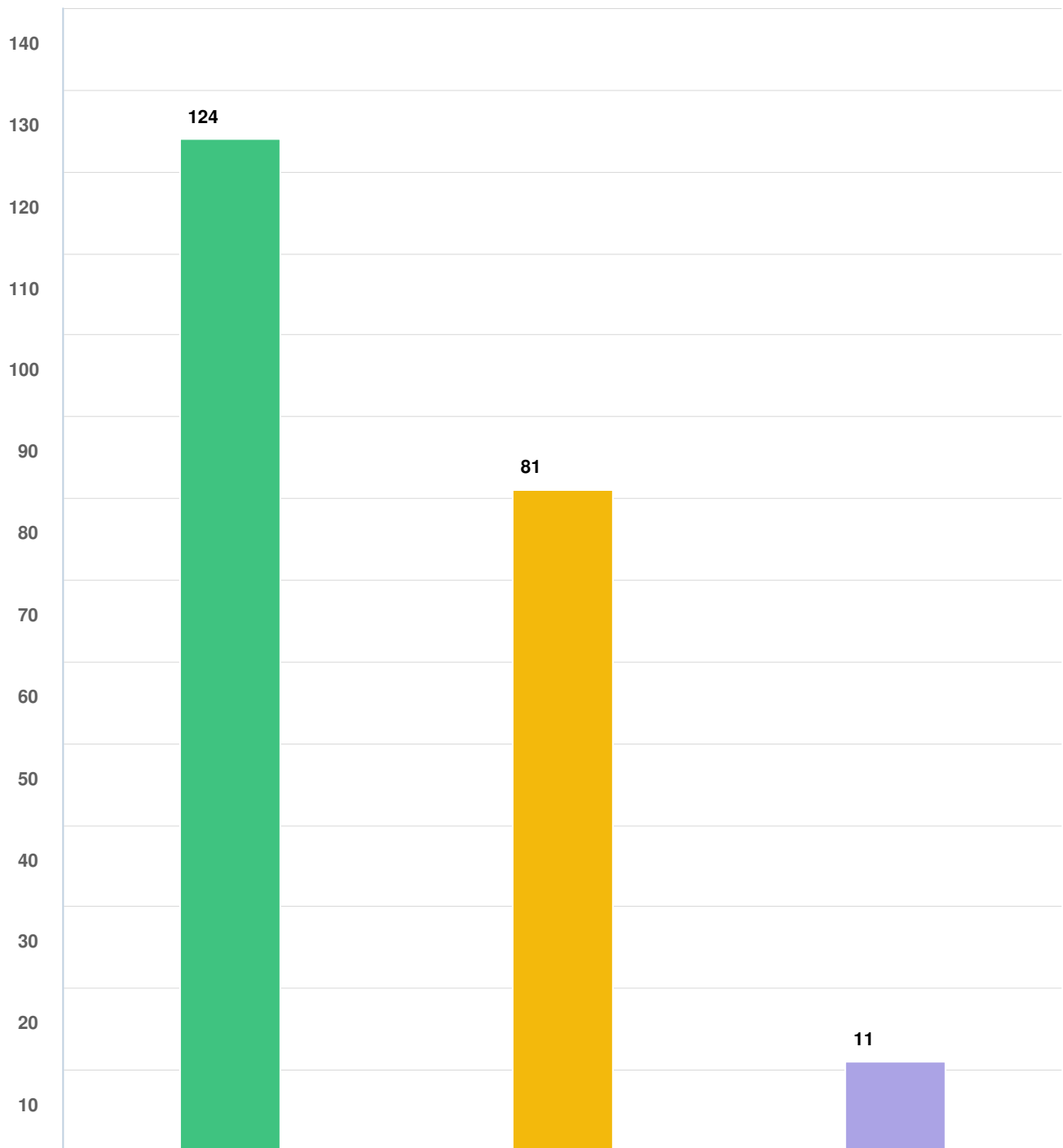

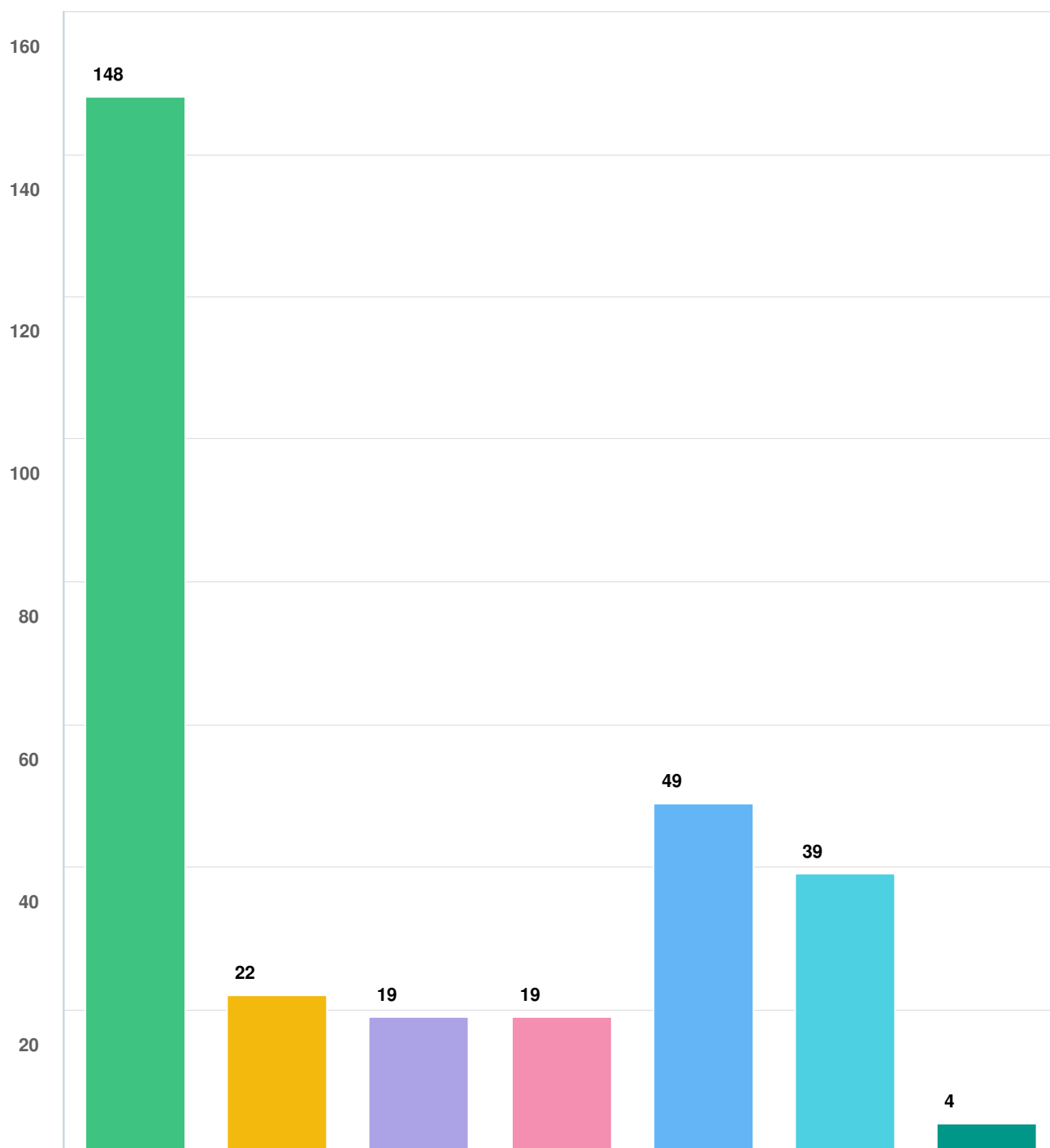

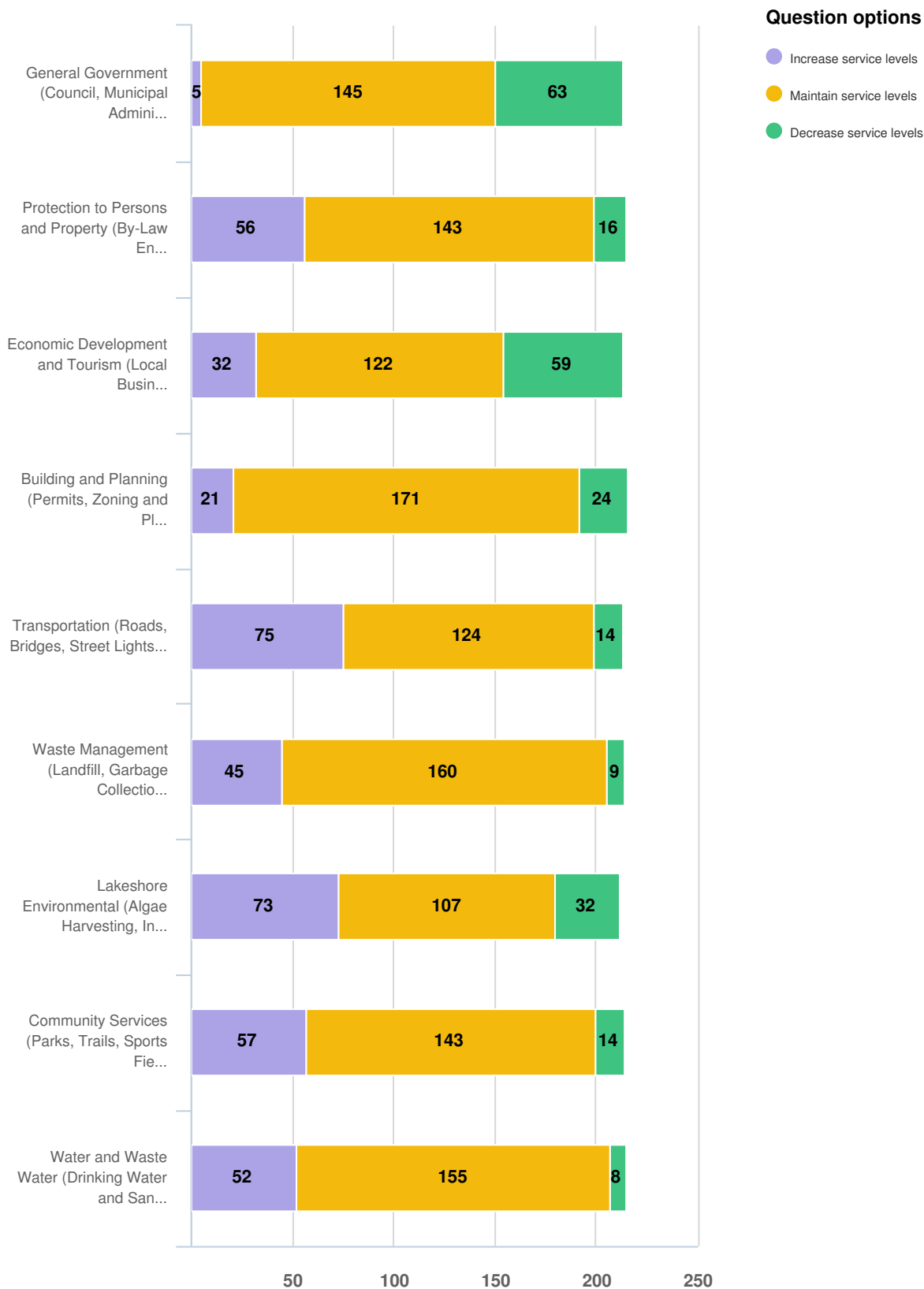

Q4 Thinking about the programs and services provided by the Township of Huron-Kinloss, would you decrease, maintain or increase services levels for the following?

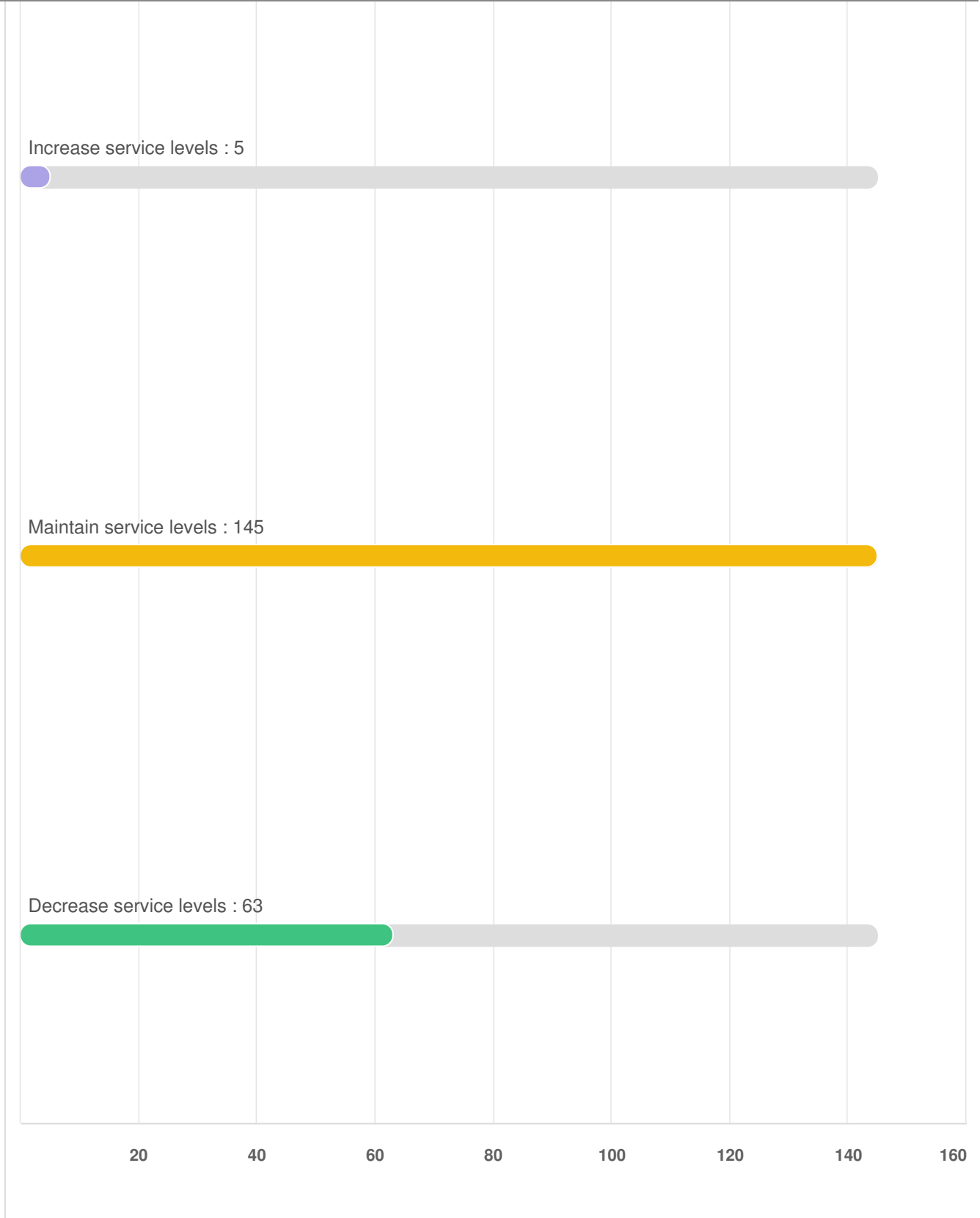

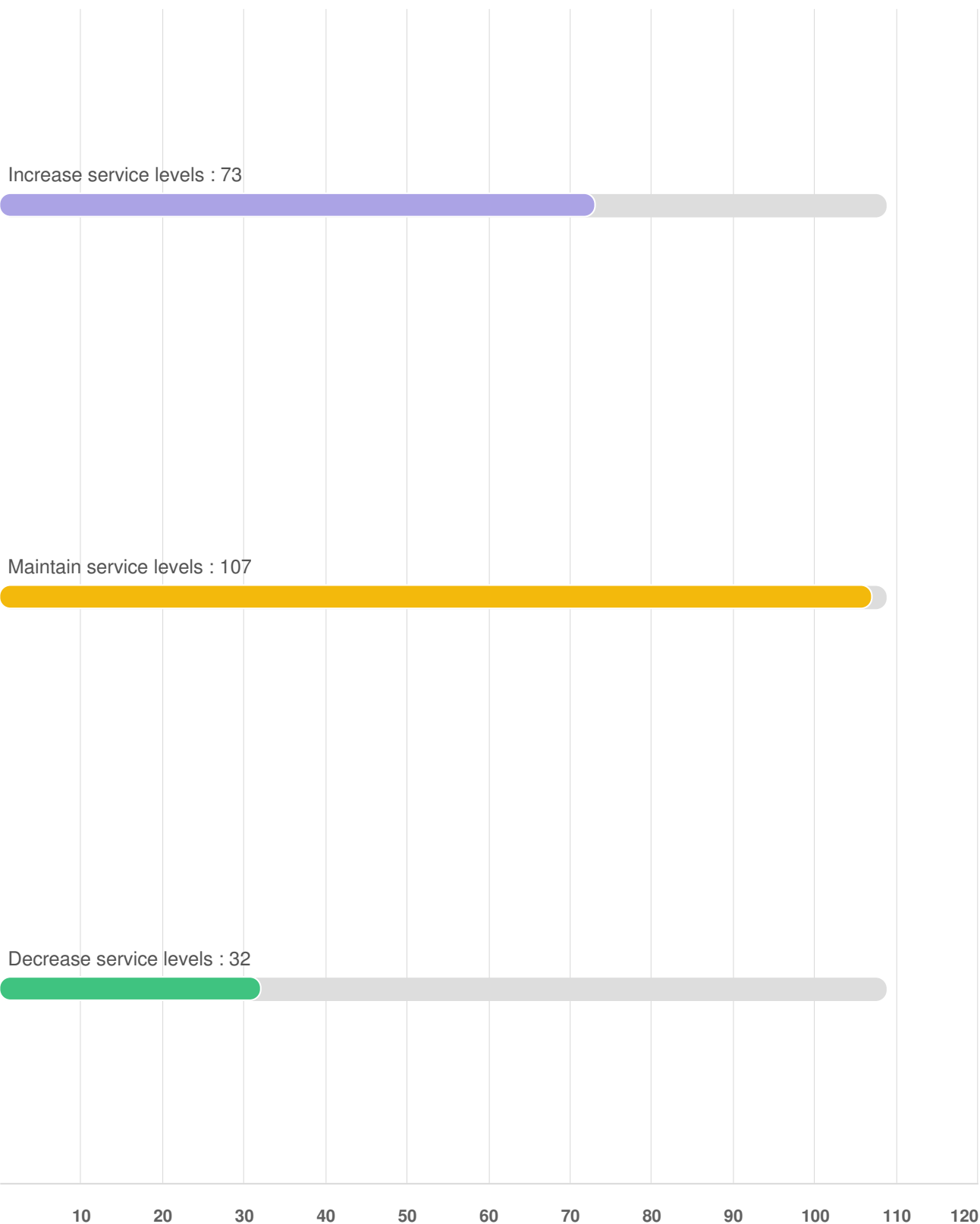

Q5 How important is it to you that funding is set aside to replace infrastructure such as roads, bridges and buildings to ensure existing levels of service can be provided in future years?



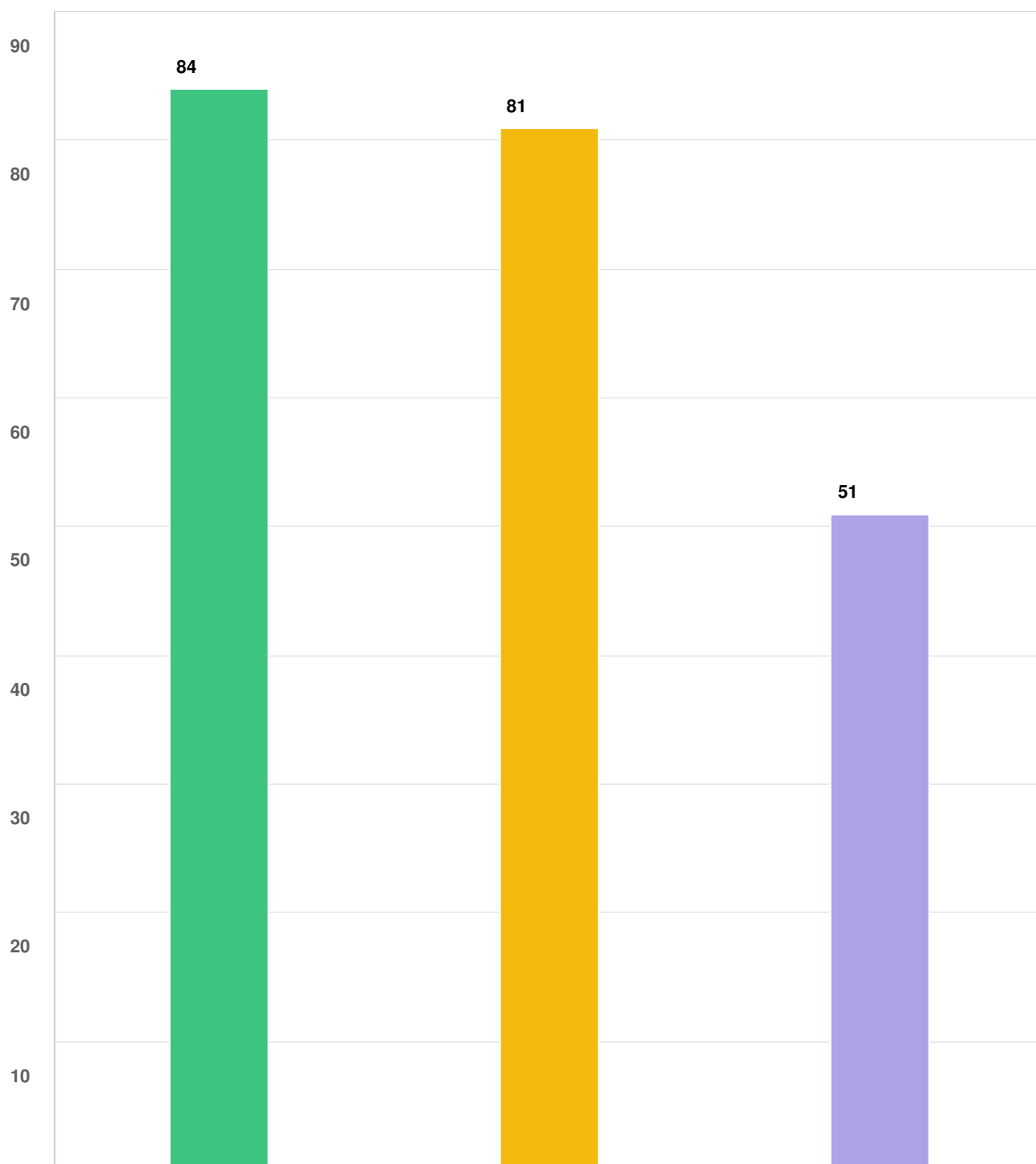

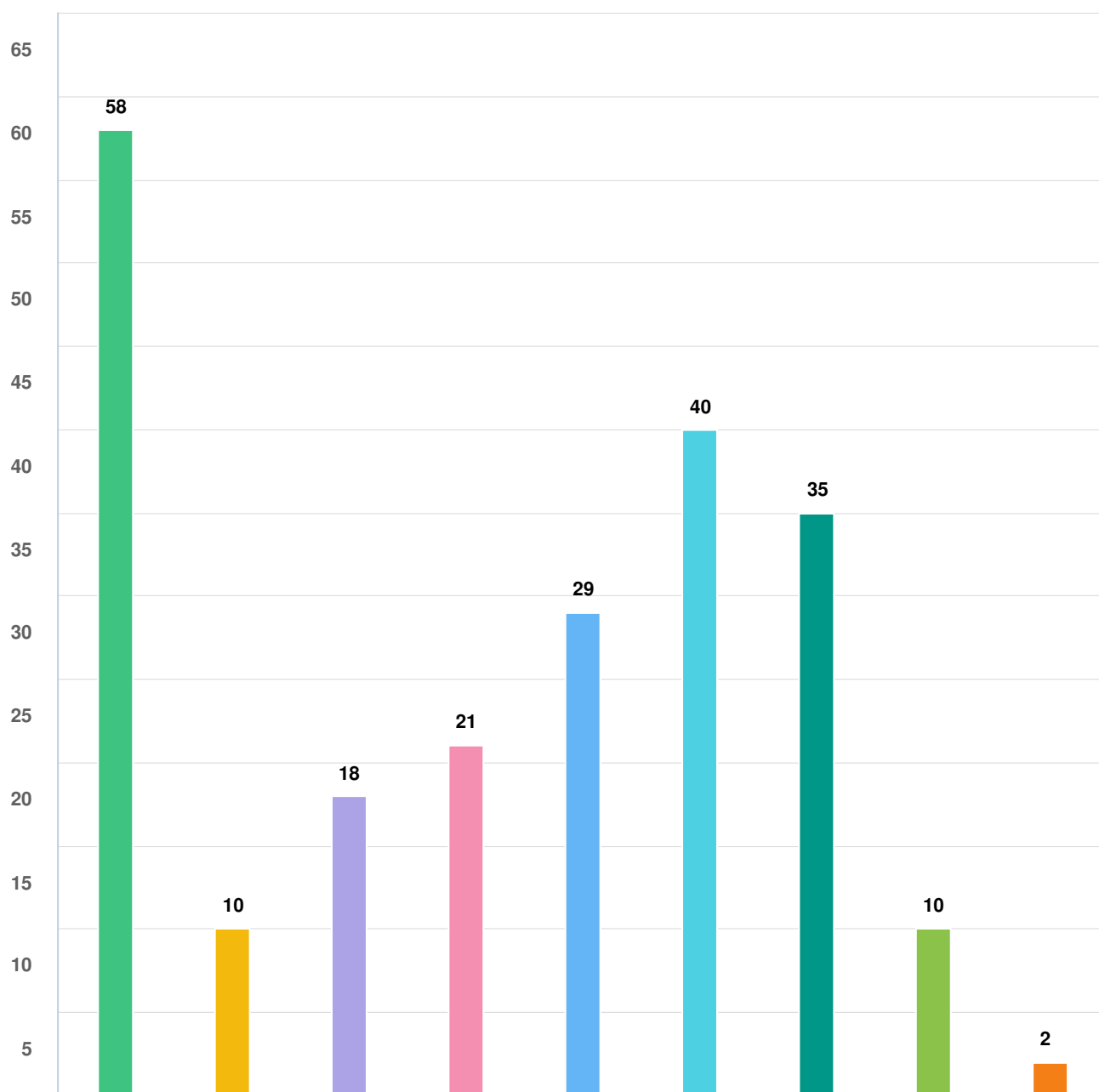

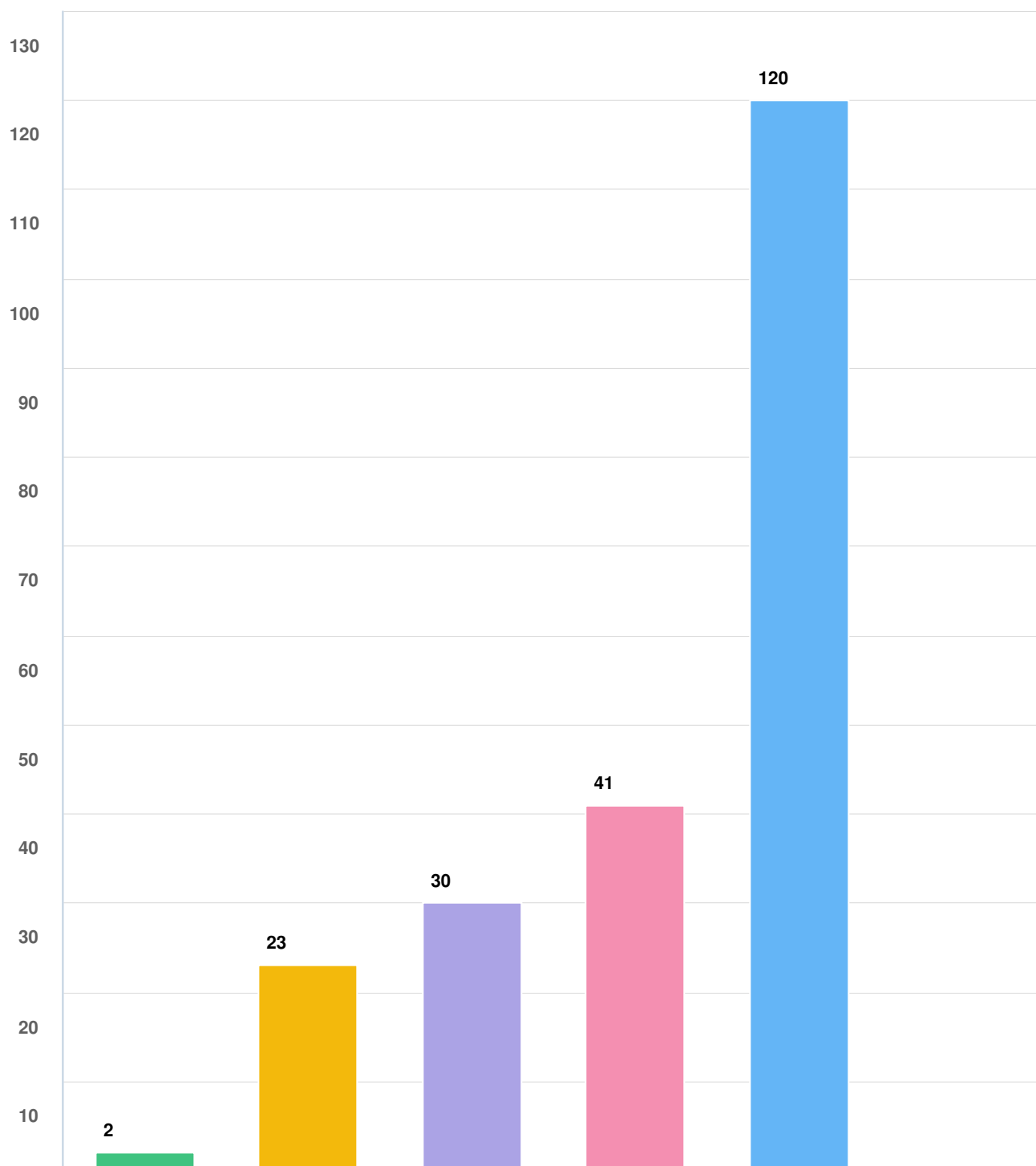

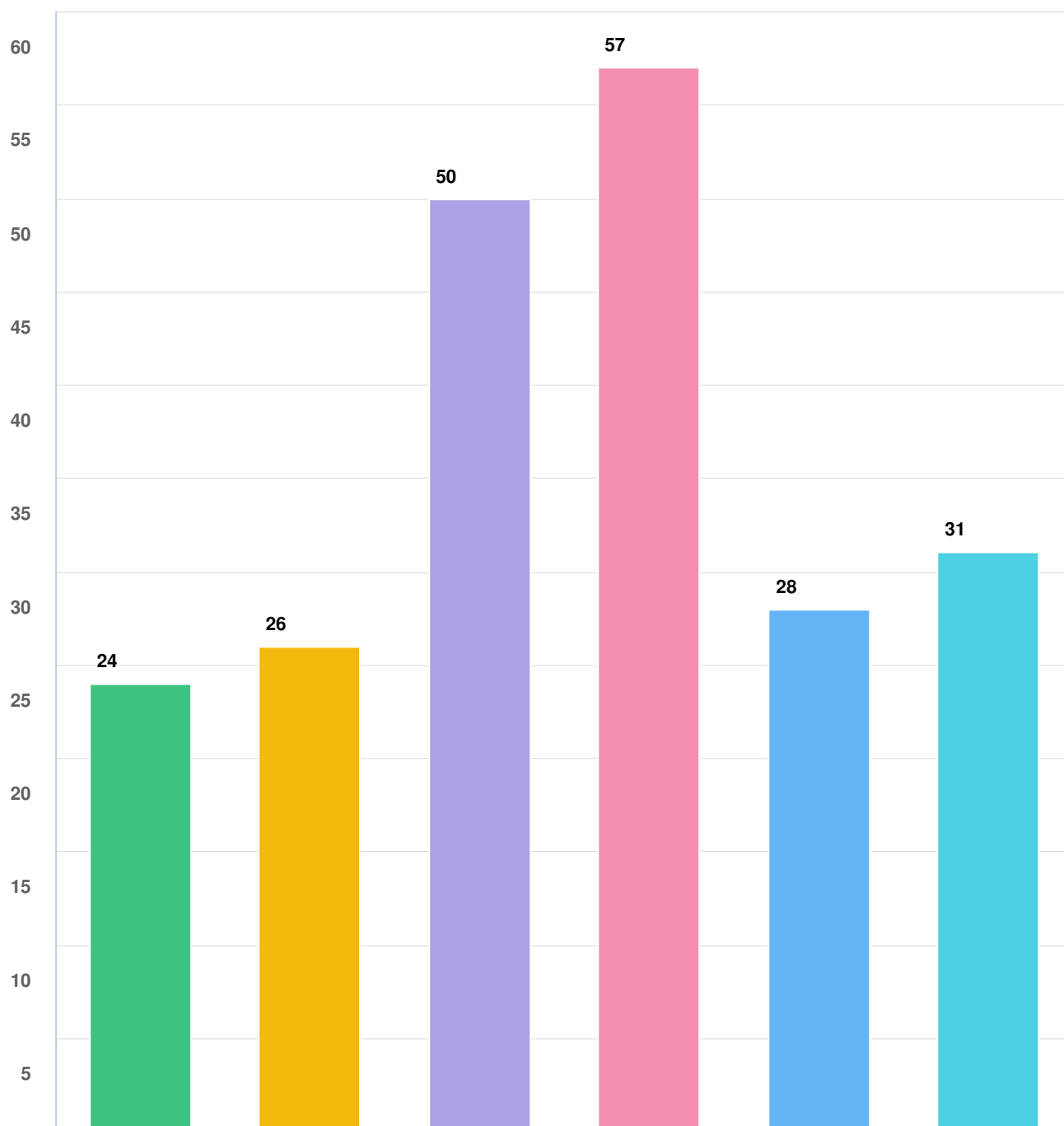
