Dog Tags	invoice dog tags and keep records up to date	
Structures on the Beach	Continue to investigate occurrences where structures have been located on public lands without first obtaining approval.	
Habitation of Accessory Building	Monitor complaints for violations of Zoning By-law and investigate any notices/ads that promote the unpermitted use.	
Wildlife Compensations Program	Investigation of wildlife attacks on farm animals when requested and submit the compensation application. Maintain records of claims.	
Property Standards	Inspect properties that do not meet compliance of the Property Standards By-law and work with the property owner and/or occupant for compliance. Attend and give evidence in an Appeal Hearing when required.	
Ash Trees on Private Property	Work with property owners who have dead or diseased ash trees that pose a hazard on their properties to have them removed.	
Kennel Inspections	Inspect all of the registered kennels in Township to make sure they meet the Code of Practice for Canadian Kennel Operations and the Animal Control/Kennel Licensing By-law. Implement standards recommended by the Provincial Animal Welfare Services (PAWS) when applicable.	
Short Term Rentals	Monitor complaints/concerns that are made and report on an annual basis.
