Digital Main Street

The \$2,500 Digital Transformation Grant application portal re-opened on January 16th. The Bruce County Digital Service Squad team hosted a virtual information session on January 20th to provide details on the program and the grant, 10 businesses registered. The team continues to meet with businesses to provide one-on-one consultations and assist with grant applications.

Grey-Bruce Entrepreneur Ecosystem

The Grey-Bruce Entrepreneur Ecosystem met in January to discuss partner updates and events for the year. The Ecosystem is made up of regional business support organizations and meets every quarter to share updates, resources, and discuss opportunities to partner for events.
