The series will be delivered in person and online in every province and territory and provides an opportunity to meet with TIAC and its partners to better understand efforts on national and local tourism issues and provide a forum for open dialogue, discussion, and constructive debate. Digital Transformation Grant Program – Applications Now Open

The application portal for the Digital Main Street Digital Transformation Grant program is now open! The Digital Transformation Grant (DTG) program is designed to assist small businesses with adoption of technologies. The program will provide training, advisory support and grants to brick-and-mortar small businesses looking to increase their capacity through digital transformation. The grant is administered by the Ontario BIA Association (OBIAA), and is not administered by Digital Main Street. Eligible brick-and-mortar small businesses can apply by creating an account and completing the digital assessment. The portal will be accepting applications until September 30th, 2023. Third Edition of Skode Program Launches

Indigenous Tourism Ontario (ITO) and the Tourism Innovation Lab (TIL) have launched the third edition of the Skode Program, an initiative to spark new Indigenous tourism ideas and experiences that authentically represent, celebrate, and promote Indigenous culture, heritage, language, cuisine, and communities in Ontario.

This year's special edition Skode program will reward a \$5,000 non-repayable financial contribution and 3-month mentorship to three winners from Northern Ontario and three winners from Southern Ontario. All six winners will then be invited to compete in a province-wide pitch session before a judge panel of Indigenous tourism leaders, entrepreneurs, and partner representatives for a chance to win the \$20,000 grand prize. 
