Discussion:

The general administration budget accounts for the wages and expenditures related to the day-to-day operations of the municipal office. It also includes the municipal contribution to the specialized transit service Saugeen Mobility and Regional Transit (SMART).

Highlights from 2022 include:

\$25,617.75 was received in a one-time surplus distribution from Workplace Safety and Insurance Board (WSIB).

Municipal election completed in 2022. A transfer to reserve of \$10,000.00 is proposed to prepare for the 2026 election.

A renovation to the lower level of the municipal administration building was completed to improve office space and new furniture purchased for Council Chambers.

An annual Christmas party has traditionally been held for all staff and volunteers. The event has not been held since the pandemic and a token of appreciation has taken its place. The event requires significant planning and with rising costs of catering and entertainment it may require additional resources. Would Council like to resume the in person traditional event or explore other options?

Treasurer's Comments:

The requests for grants to organizations are attached for Council's review. No new grants are proposed at this time. The information on municipal contributions for SMART was provided by the organization. Our Board representative may have additional information to share.
