Discussion:

The Conservation Authorities budgets are drafted by the respective Authority and distributed to the member municipalities for support.

The Saugeen Valley Conservation Authority 2023 draft budget was shared with Council last fall. The draft levy for Huron-Kinloss is \$114,758.00; an increase of \$9,268.00 or 8.9%, It was not supported and we have not received any further information on whether changes have been made.

Special Projects include our share of the Lake Huron Centre for Coastal Conservation.

Maitland Valley Conservation Authority has provided their draft budget for review. The draft levy for Huron-Kinloss is \$111,827.00; an increase of \$4,743.00 or 4.4%. Comments are due by February 28, 2023.

Treasurer's Comments:

The draft budget also includes our share of the Flood Hazard and Identification Mapping Project that was granted pre-budget approval.
