Foodcycler FC-30

- Recommended for households with 2 residents.
- Cost to resident: \$150

Foodcycler Maestro

- Recommended for households with 2 residents.
- Cost to resident: \$300

The funded pilot program is based on a cost subsidy model where Food Cycle Science provides an initial discount, there is also an investment from Impact Canada, the Municipal Innovation Council provides a subsidy, and the resident provides the remaining contribution. Municipalities have the option to top up the 60 MIC funded units to increase the pilot size.
