Committee approved the inclusion of wording into local Community Improvement Plans that supports incentives focused on the County portion of fees and property taxes, including tax equivalent incentives, pre-development study incentives, and

permit fee incentives, where municipalities are offering the same program in local Community Improvement Plan updates. Committee also directed staff develop a framework for the utilization/implementation of these tools, which will be presented at an upcoming Committee meeting. [Report](#)

Committee approved that \$100,000 be transferred from the Waste Management Future Planning Reserves to the Capital Roads Reserve for future infrastructure needs. [Report](#)

Committee approved that a temporary community safety zone be established ending December 1, 2023, on Bruce Road 11 (Goldie Street), from the Bruce Road 3 (Queen Street) intersection for a distance of 500m to the east. Committee approved the changes to the Community Safety Zone by-law as presented and placed the by-law on an upcoming Council agenda for adoption.
