There are lots of dead trees on the unused road and they are falling into the farmed land. I cleaned up the dead trees of my farm as well as some of the unassumed road. I was not aware of the fact that there was a 15 meter strip that Huron Kinloss property as the previous owner farmed that as well. After this I tiled the farm.

Mr Yungblut is proposing planting trees 15 meters out of the unassumed road. I am concerned the roots of the trees will plug up the tiles and this will make the farm less productive. The unused road has not been maintained and there are lots of dead trees falling into our farm properties. This is a liability for everyone involved.
