Responding to COVID-19

- OPG continues to provide 50% of Ontario's electricity for homes, business, hospitals. #PowerON
- Donations of 1.1 million masks and other PPE for health care workers; support for food banks across Ontario.
- In OPG workplace, including WWMF: Protocols to keep our staff safe, including masks and physical distancing.
- Supporting economic recovery of Ontario post-COVID, including private-sector suppliers in smaller and rural communities – such as Abraflex, in Paisley.
- Sponsorship of “virtual” local events (e.g., Pumpkinfest).

Western Waste Management Facility

- Strong safety performance continues: 8 years without a lost-time accident
- WWMF expansion continues:
 - 5 new Multi-Purpose Storage Buildings (3 in design phase).
 - Used Fuel Storage Buildings 5 & 6 – construction underway.
- 2020 upgrades to incinerator completed.

Lasting Solutions

- OPG remains committed to the safe and permanent disposal of nuclear by-products.
- Multiple options for alternate solutions may be explored in parallel.
- Any new site-selection process for a disposal facility would engage with stakeholders, Indigenous communities and the public.
- OPG will look to see whether an upcoming federal review of the radioactive-waste policy framework identifies alternate solutions.
- OPG continues to embrace the three Rs to minimize and divert by-products: Reduce, reuse, recycle.
