The Municipality of Morris-Turnberry passed a resolution at its November 8, 2017 meeting to appoint Dietrich Engineering Limited to prepare an Engineer's Report for the "Thompson Lamont Deyell Municipal Drain 2020", serving the following Lots and Concessions in the Municipality of Morris-Turnberry, Turnberry Ward, County of Huron: Lots 10 to 30, Concession B, Lots 23 to 30, Concession 10, Lots 23 to 30, Concession 11, Lots 25 to 35, Concession 12, and In the Township of North Huron, East Wawanosh Ward, County of Huron: Lots 30 to 35, Concession 14, and In the Municipality of South Bruce, Culross Ward, County of Bruce: Lots 33 to 35, Concession 1, and in the **Township of Huron-Kinloss, Kinloss Ward, County of Bruce: Lots 1 to 12, Concession 1, Lots 35 to 40, Concession 2**

A meeting to consider the report for the Thompson Lamont Deyell Municipal Drain will be presented to the Council of the Municipality of Morris-Turnbury at its November 3rd Council meeting on Zoom.
