Summary of Events

By-Law Enforcement

A notice went to a resident that owns property on a corner lot who recently planted cedar trees. The trees were planted on the road allowance adjacent to their property. The Township has requested that the cedar trees be removed do to the line of sight for drivers and pedestrians now being limited.

Animal Control

One dog was taken to the Pound and later reunited with the owner. Before retrieving the dog, the owner paid the retrieval fee and a dog tag.

Property Standards

Three properties received letters requesting that their properties be brought into compliance under the Property Standard By-Law. The infractions included unsightly yards and lawn maintenance.

Parking

Two notices were placed on vehicles that have been parked on road allowances for a duration of time. The notices state that the removal of the vehicles from the road allowance is needed. Compliance will be monitored.
