BY-LAW

2023 - 54

Being a By-law to Amend By-law No. 2022-198; Being a By-Law to Appoint Michele Barr as Deputy Chief Building Official

WHEREAS Section 3(2) of the Building Code Act, 1992, S.O. 1992, c. 23, as amended, provides that each municipality shall appoint a chief building official and such inspectors as are necessary for the enforcement of this Act in the areas in which the municipality has jurisdiction;

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 34 of the Planning Act the Council for The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss passed the Township of Huron-Kinloss Comprehensive Zoning By-Law No. 2018-98, and deems it expedient to a appoint Zoning Administrator to enforce the Township of Huron -Kinloss Zoning By-law, as amended;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss to fill a vacancy in the position, through By-law No. 2023 - has appointed a new Chief Building Official;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss deems it expedient to appoint Michele Barr as Deputy Chief Building Official for the Township of Huron-Kinloss to fulfil the statutory and administration duties of the position;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss enacts as follows:

1. That Section 1 of By-law No. 2022-198 be repealed and replaced with the following:

That Michele Barr be appointed Deputy Chief Building Official for The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss, and shall in the absence of the Chief Building Official, perform all duties assigned, legislated and required of a Chief Building Official.
2. That this appointment shall be effective as of May 15, 2023.
3. This By-law shall come into force and effect upon its final passage.
4. This By-law may be cited as the “Appointment Deputy Chief Building Official (Michele Barr) By-Law”.
