Being a By-Law to Accept a Request for Tender for Maintenance Gravel (Johnson Bros [Bothwell] Ltd.)

WHEREAS Section 8(1) and 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provide that the powers of a municipality under this or any other Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues and has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purposes of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS The Council for The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss deems it expedient to accept a tender for the supply, haul and placement of Granular, 'A' maintenance gravel for the purpose of gravel road maintenance for Township of Huron-Kinloss 2023, per Report PW-2023-04-21;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss **ENACTS** as follows;

- That the request for tender of Johnson Bros. (Bothwell) Ltd. in the amount of \$14.50 plus HST per tonne for the supply, hauling and placement of Granular 'A' maintenance gravel on various roads in the Township of Huron-Kinloss be hereby accepted
- That the Director of Public Works and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign on behalf
 of the Council for The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss, any contracts
 and other documents required to authorize the agreement, and to affix the
 corporate seal of the Township of Huron-Kinloss.
- 3. That this by-law shall come into full force and effect upon its final passage.
- 4. That this by-law may be cited as the "2023 Gravel Maintenance Tender Acceptance By-law".
