Background:

This report provides an update of Emergency Management and Health and Safety activities.

Discussion:

Emergency Management

Emergency Preparedness Week was May 7-13. Daily public education was posted on social media, activity sheets were provided to Lucknow and Ripley Public Schools and a cottage and RV emergency preparedness checklist was shared with cottage associations, camp grounds and trailer parks.

The Emergency Services/ Health & Safety Coordinator received two special event applications in May and continues to work with event organizers to ensure Special Event Permit requirements are met.

The Emergency Services/ Health & Safety Coordinator was invited to attend the Ashfield-Colborne-Wawanosh annual exercise to participate as an observer/evaluator. The full-scale exercise was in partnership with Snobelen Farms Dungannon Elevator.

Health & Safety

As of June 1, 2023 the Occupational Health and Safety Act requires workplaces with a risk of employee opioid overdose to provide naloxone. Staff have completed a risk assessment for each location and determined there is no risk at this time.

Training: Emergency Services/ Health and Safety Coordinator continues to meet with departments monthly completing Safety Tailgate training on internal policies, procedures, and applicable Safety Data Sheets (SDS). New employees have been assigned orientation training to complete.

Inspections: Regular monthly inspections were completed at Township facilities. A group inspection was completed at the Huron-Landfill with the Huron-Kinloss committee. A group inspection was also completed with the Lucknow & District Fire Department committee.

Incident Reporting: There were no incidents in May.

Joint Health and Safety Committee: The Township of Huron-Kinloss committee met in May.

COVID-19
