- Connection between priorities with budget



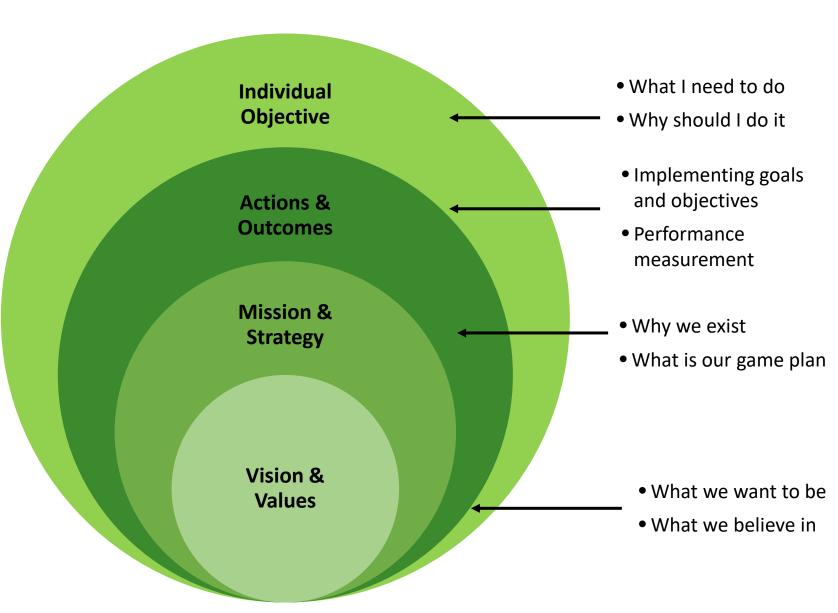
# Strategic Planning
