BY-LAW

2022- 195

Being a By-law to Dedicate Land as Part of Angus Road

in the Township of Huron-Kinloss

WHEREAS the Municipal Act S.O. 2001, c 25, Section 5(1), as amended, provides that the powers of a municipal corporation are to be exercised by its Council;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Act S.O. 2001, c 25, Section 5(3), as amended, provides that a municipal power, including a municipality's capacity rights, powers and privileges under Section 9; shall be exercised by By-Law;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Act S.O. 2001, c 25, Section 26 sets out what constitutes a highway for all municipalities in Ontario;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss has acquired certain land within the Ripley Industrial Park in the Township of Huron-Kinloss and deems it expedient to dedicate this land as part of Angus Road in the Township of Huron-Kinloss;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss enacts as follows:

- 1.0 That the following lands namely: ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel of land and premises, situate, and lying and being in the Township of Huron-Kinloss in the County of Bruce, and Province of Ontario, being on that property designated as Part of Lot 14 Concession 7, more particularly described as Part 17 on RP 3R-10651 having PIN 33324-0157, Part 6 (Angus Street) RP 264 having PIN 33324-0157, and Part 9 on RP 3R 10651 having PIN 33324-0162, having been acquired by The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss is hereby dedicated as public highway and forms part of Angus Road in the Township of Huron-Kinloss.
- 2.0 This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon passing.
- 3.0 This By-law may be cited as the "Road Dedication – Angus Road By-Law"
