BY-LAW No.

2023 –

Being a By-law to amend By-law No. 2018-98; Being the Comprehensive Zoning By-law of the Township of Huron-Kinloss Holding Removal Concession 5 Part Lots 1 and 2 (Stanely)

WHEREAS By-Law No. 2018-98 placed certain lands in “Agriculture Special Holding” zoning and specified the use to which lands, buildings and structures may be put until such time as the holding symbol is removed pursuant to Section 36 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c . P. 132;

AND WHEREAS the Council for The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss deems it expedient to amend By-Law No. 2018-98, as amended; being the Comprehensive Zoning By-Law for the Township of Huron-Kinloss;

AND WHEREAS the provisions relating to the removal of the holding symbol contained in By-Law No. 2018-98 have been satisfied;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss, pursuant to Section 36 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990 **ENACTS** as follows:

- 1.0 That Schedule ‘A’ to By-Law No. 2018-98, is hereby amended by changing the zoning symbol on part of the lands described as Concession 5 Part Lots 1 and 2 - Township of Huron-Kinloss (geographic Township of Huron) from “AG1-25.1-H1’ General Agriculture Special Holding to AG1-25.1 General Agriculture Special as outlined on Schedule ‘A’, attached to and forming a part of this By-Law.
- 2.0 That this By-Law shall come into full force and effect from the date of passage by Council subject to the provisions of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.
- 3.0 This by-law may be cited as the “Stanley (Concession 5 Part Lots 1 and 2) Zoning Holding Removal By-Law”.

READ a FIRST and SECOND TIME this 18th day of September, 2023.

READ a THIRD TIME and FINALLY PASSED this 18th day of September, 2023.
