THIS LETTER IS FROM A NUMBER OF DOG KENNEL OWNER/  
OPERATORS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HURON-KINLOSSTHERE IS A NEW KENNEL CODE OF PRACTISE THAT IS  
TO COME INTO EFFECT ON DEC 31 2023. WE HAVE CONCERNS  
ABOUT SOME<sup>OF THE</sup> REQUIREMENTS.\* SPENDING AS MUCH TIME WITH DOGS AND PUPPIES AS THE  
KENNEL CODE REQUIRES IS NOT POSSIBLE FOR US. (See: A Code  
of Practice For Canadian Dog Kennel Operations 3.3.4 REQUIREMENTS,  
note especially 4, 5, 6, 7.) WE DO REALIZE PUPPIES AND  
ADULT DOGS NEED ENOUGH HUMAN CONTACT TO BE SOCIABLE.\* IT IS VERY DIFFICULT FOR US TO COME UP TO TEMPERATURE  
AND HUMIDITY REQUIREMENTS. USING FANS AND/OR AIR CON-  
DITIONING IN DOG KENNELS IS NOT SUITABLE FOR OUR LIFE-  
STYLE (see: A Code of Practise For Canadian Dog Kennel Operations  
1.1.6 REQUIREMENTS)THANK YOU IN ADVANCE FOR YOUR HELP AND CONSIDER-  
ATION BY LOOKING INTO THIS MATTER FOR USThe above concerns were discussed and agreed upon in a meeting
