BEING A BY-LAW TO ADOPT A DRY CULVERT POLICY FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF HURON-KINLOSS

WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Huron-Kinloss deems it expedient to establish a Dry Culvert policy in order to regulate the installation of culverts on Municipal road allowances;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Township of Huron-Kinloss **ENACTS** as follows:

- 1.0 The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss hereby adopts the Dry Culvert Policy contained in the attached Schedule "A" to this by-law.
- 2.0 This By-Law shall come into full force and effect upon its final passage.
- 3.0 This By-law may by cited as the "Dry Culvert Policy By-Law".

SECTION:	Public Works	POLICY: Dry Culvert Policy
Coverage:	This policy will govern the installation of services underneath municipal roads in the Township of Huron-Kinloss.	
Policy Statement:	The purpose of this policy is to regulate road cuts made for the installation of dry culverts under municipal roads and to further regulate the use of such culverts.	
Guiding Principles:	Road cuts are prohibited for installation of private works on all surface treated and hard topped municipal roads. "Pushing" of infrastructure through the road bed will be the preferred method.	
	Where dry culverts are used as conduits for other works, the owner shall demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Township, that there will be no threat to the environment through inadvertent discharges (manure piping systems).	
	Permit and deposit fees for installation shall be as established in the Township's Consolidated Fee By-Law, as amended.
