1. Call to Order

Mayor Murray called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

2. Disclosure of Pecuniary Interest

None disclosed.

3. Delegations

3.1 Kincardine and Community Health Care Foundation

Murray Elston of the Kincardine and Community Health Care Foundation presented to Council an update on to the Kincardine Hospital

Redevelopment, and the announcement of a new Magnetic Resonance Imagining (MRI) project.

Elston announced that the CT Scanner is now in use, and that 1238 scans have been completed to date on the new scanner. The CT Scanner was included in the Phase 1 Redevelopment project. The MRI is expected to have 2500 scans done per year. The benefits to patients of including an MRI in the redevelopment project include a reduced wait time, a decrease in travel required (particularly evening/night travel), and better access/appointment times for patients.

Including the MRI in fundraising goals, increases the Foundation's fundraising goal effectively from \$12 million to \$18 million. Because of the benefits of the MRI, the Foundation is requesting that the Township of Huron-Kinloss consider revising its financial commitment to the campaign by contributing \$900,000 (\$150,000 per year for 6 years) to help fund this essential medical service. Similar scaled requests are currently being made to the County of Bruce, and Municipality of Kincardine to reflect the immense benefit all will receive from having this valuable medical resource in our community.

Elston speculated that the Wingham hospital would not be obtaining an MRI machine.

Committee indicated that this request would be considered during budget deliberations.

Committee inquired about the warranty period. Staff suggested the warranty would be for several years yet, and that they don't have concerns about the workmanship of the company in general. A more thorough investigation will occur in the spring, to determine the exact reasons why there was a product failure and ways to mitigate this.

Committee discussed the Southwest Ripley Street Rebuilding. They noted that the plan called for trees to be cut down to bring the area to a more urban streetscape. Committee supported from a safety perspective, the installation of sidewalks over saving the trees.

Committee inquired about the location of sidewalks on the north side of that road rather than the south side. Staff indicated that this had been considered in planning. The grade of the hill on the south side did not support a sidewalk on that side. Committee inquired about the maintenance of walkways, and whether there was a policy on maintaining walkways. Staff suggested that although the report suggested this walkway could be maintained, that the Township does not maintain any walkways in urban areas. This is consistent across the various urban areas.
