3. Ripley Summer Sports Policies

The Ripley Summer Sports Committee discussed and made changes to the Team Selection Policy and include evaluation games as part of the team selection process. The Committee reviewed a Code of Conduct for Coaches Policy. Information for this policy was taken directly from the Western Ontario Baseball Association as well as the Canada Soccer Code of Conduct and Ethics and will be used and communicated to Ripley Minor Baseball and Ripley Minor Soccer coaches.

Committee agreed to add the Code of Conduct for Spectators and Parents to the 2024 registration form:

Spectators and Parents are expected to:

- Encourage athletes to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence; Never ridicule a participant for making a mistake during a performance or practice;
- Provide positive comments that motivate and encourage participants' continued effort;
- Respect the decisions and judgments of officials and encourage athletes to do the same;
- Respect and show appreciation to all competitors, and to the coaches, officials, and other volunteers who give their time to the sport; and
- Refrain from entering the training or competition area and from interfering with any activities.
- If you have a problem/conflict/concern with a Manager/Coaches, do not approach them during or after a game/practice. Wait at least 24 hours and then contact the coach to discuss the matter or set a meeting with the Manager or Coach to discuss the matter.

There is a concern for with the program with a lack of registration and the number of qualified/knowledgeable soccer coaches or parents, interested in taking on a coaching position with Ripley Minor Soccer. Soccer Contact Pollock will connect with Kincardine Minor Soccer and discuss options for next season.

Committee Member Kortegaard purchased materials and installed new shelving at the Ripley Summer Sports Equipment Shed with the help of community members on October 14.

Equipment Manager Dewar will transfer equipment that should be kept indoors, from the storage shed to the equipment room inside the Ripley Arena.
