THAT the Township of Huron-Kinloss Committee of the Whole hereby receives for information Report CLK-2024-05-19 prepared by Kelly Lush, Deputy Clerk;

AND grants an exemption to the Noise By-law No. 2005-101 to permit music at a wedding reception on Saturday July 6, 2024 from 9:00 p.m. until 1:00 a.m. on Sunday, July 7, 2024 located at 353 Lake Range Drive, Kincardine;

AND FURTHER grants an exemption to the Noise By-law No. 2005-101 to permit music at a wedding reception on Saturday, September 7, 2024 from 9:00 p.m. until 1:00 a.m. on Sunday, September 8, 2024 located at 701 Yosacha Place, Kincardine.

Background:

The Township of Huron-Kinloss By-Law No. 2005-101 being the By-Law to Control Noise outlines prohibitions of noise by time and place. The By-law prohibits;

3.5 The operation of any electronic device or group of connected electronic devices incorporating one or more loudspeakers or other electromechanical transducers, and intended for the production, reproduction or amplification of sound between the hours of 2300 one day to 07 00 next day (09 00 Sundays).

Council may by resolution grant an exemption to the Noise By-Law.

Discussion/Analysis/Overview:

The Township received a noise exemption request from Austin Rees to have music played at a wedding reception Saturday July 6, 2024 from 9:00 p.m. until 1:00 a.m. on Sunday, July 7, 2024 located at 353 Lake Range Drive, Kincardine.

A request was received from Hayley Martyn to have music played at a wedding reception on Saturday, September 7, 2024 from 9:00 p.m. until 1:00 a.m. on Sunday, September 8, 2024 located at 701 Yosacha Place, Kincardine.

The requests were circulated to Township staff. No concerns were noted. Staff recommends approval of the exemption requests and will encourage the applicants

to notify their neighbours. If approved, the O.P.P. will be notified.	Township By-Law Officer and South Bruce
