Being a By-law to Appoint Valerie Hawkes as a Hearing Officer and Screening Officer under the Administrative Monetary Penalties System By-Law for the Township of Huron-Kinloss

WHEREAS Section 8(1) and 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provide that the powers of a municipality under this or any other Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues and has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purposes of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

WHEREAS the Council for the Township of Huron-Kinloss established a system of administrative monetary penalties system for the designated municipal by-laws and established the position of Hearing Officer and Screening Officer to who may be delegated quasi-judicial and other authority under By-law No. 2024-40;

WHEREAS the Council for the Township of Huron-Kinloss deems it advisable to appoint a Hearing Officer and Screening Officer herein referred to for the purposes designated.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss **ENACTS** as follows:

- 1.0 That the Council of the Township of Huron-Kinloss hereby appoints Valerie Hawkes as a Hearing Officer and Screening Officer to conduct the review process as per By-law 2024-40;
- 2.0 That a Hearing Officer and Screening Officer shall have no authority to further delegate his/her powers or duties;
- 3.0 This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon final passage.
- 4.0 This By-law may be cited as the "Appoint Hawkes as a Hearing and Screening Officer under the AMPS By-Law"
