In the spring, MacGregor Point is one of Lthe finest locations in Ontario to see migrating songbirds. Hundreds of millions of these winged travellers advance across the continent in endless waves of colour, following centuries-old migration routes to their breeding grounds. The Huron Fringe, a treed corridor that skirts the eastern shore of Lake Huron, leads migrating birds towards the Bruce Peninsula and across the upper Great Lakes into the boreal forests beyond.
