Recommendation:

THAT the Township of Huron-Kinloss Council hereby receive Report BLD-2024-06-15 as prepared by Staff;

AND FURTHER THAT a By-law authorizing staff to sign the agreement be brought forward to the July 15, 2024 Council meeting.

Background:

The current agreement with Cloudpermit is expiring on September 15, 2024. Staff had heard that Cloudpermit fees were increasing across the County and preemptively requested a renewal quote. The initial renewal quote was \$30,000/year for a term of 3 years. Staff met with Cloudpermit and expressed concerns over the jump in price and have received a revised 3 year quote with year 1 \$20,000, year 2 \$25,000 and year 3 \$30,000. Cloudpermit will only negotiate a 3 year agreement.

Discussion/Analysis/Overview:

Cloudpermit is an online community development software that provides local governments with Software-as-a-Service (SaaS) products available 24-7. This allows remote and mobile work on-site and ensures that all parties receive real-time information about applications, inspections and approvals. The program integrates with our GIS application to get accurate location data and up to date property information. It allows the public and developers to submit and track their building applications online and is used across the County.

Some of the benefits of using Cloudpermit are:

- The information from Cloudpermit is available to the Township's stakeholders such as B.M. Ross and is used for the issuance of septic permits.
- The completed building permits and plans are automatically shared with MPAC to ensure timely and accurate assessment values and dates.
- The legislated required building permit information is also automatically shared with Stats Can.
- Cloudpermit is working on an integration with Laserfiche to automatically save permits and related information to our records retention and roll files.

The Township is anticipating future developments in Ripley, Lucknow and along the lakeshore, and having Cloudpermit will assist those developers with applying and scheduling inspections for those new buildings. Staff understands that for the average property owner wanting to build that Cloudpermit may not be more efficient, however, it does streamline the process for developers and staff.

There were 244 permits issued in 2023 and approx. 1200 inspections booked through the cloudpermit system.

For the current year there have been 89 permits issued to date with 537 inspections booked through the cloudpermit system.

Financial Impacts:

The cost of Cloudpermit software was 5.5% of the building permit revenue in 2023. This cost will be higher for 2024 and 2025, however, will decline as building permit revenue increases with new development.

Cloudpermit has just launched an inspection app that is fully functional on all devices and out of cell phone range that they will include free in the renewal price.

We have received a quote from another software company that provides a cloud based permit system and the 1st year with installation will be approx. \$60,950.00, 2nd and 3rd year including support would be approx. \$31,960.00.
