Background:

These resolutions were received from other Ontario Municipalities for consideration.

Discussion/Analysis/Overview:

- a) Loyalist Township and the Municipality of Chatham-Kent are requesting that the Province amend Ontario Regulation 391/21: Blue Box so that producers are responsible for the end of life management of recycling products from all sources including businesses, places of worship, daycares, campgrounds, municipal owned buildings, commercial farms and not for profit organizations.
- b) The Municipality of Brighton is requesting that the Province of Ontario take the responsibility of ride share regulations and licencing to contribute to a more streamlined and uniform governance structure, eliminating red tape and unnecessary administrative costs.
- c) The City of Quite-West is calling on the Federal Government to re-evaluate their lack of funding for municipalities with a population less than 50,000 in rural Ontario and make available funding for infrastructure programs to help build infrastructure to help build much needed new homes. The city is also asking that the Province of Ontario invest more than the currently allocated \$200M into their Housing Enabling Water Systems Fund.

- d) The Municipality of Tweed is calling on the Ontario government to immediately implement sustainable funding for small rural municipalities by reabsorbing the cost of the Ontario Provincial Police Force back into the provincial budget with no cost recovery to municipalities.
