BY-LAW No.

Being a By-Law to Delegate Certain Powers and Duties (Signing Authority)

WHEREAS Section 23.1 of the Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended authorizes a municipality to delegate its powers under this or any other Act to a person or body, subject to certain restrictions;

AND WHEREAS Section 270 of the Municipal Act, 2001. S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended provides that a municipality shall adopt and maintain policies respecting the delegation of its powers and duties;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss adopted a Delegation of Powers and Duties Policy by By-law No. 2007-131 on December 17, 2007;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss passed a by-law to establish a Signing Authority By-law to permit certain officers to sign cheques on behalf of the Township;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss deems it appropriate to delegate authority from Council to the officers and employees of the municipality for the purpose of providing responsible, accountable, good and efficient government;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss **ENACTS** as follows;

1. That the Mayor and the Clerk or their designates, are hereby appointed signing officers for The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss and may jointly execute any document on behalf of the Municipality unless specifically provided for in any other delegation of authority by-law or statute.
2. That this authority does not apply as signing officers for cheques as established by By-law No. 2017- 82 or its successors
3. That this by-law shall come into full force and effect upon its final passage.
4. That this by-law may be cited as the "Delegation of Powers and Duties (Signing Officers) By-law".
