Background:

These resolutions were received from other Ontario Municipalities for consideration.

Discussion/Analysis/Overview:

- a. The Township of Nairn and Hyman is demanding that the Province of Ontario and the Ministry of Mines and Ministry of Transportation immediately halt the project involving the transportation and deposition Naturally Occurring Radioactive Material (NORM) to the Agnew Lake Tailings Management Area (ALTMA) until a clear line of communication is established with local municipalities and full disclosure of the transportation and deposition plan, transportation routes, emergency response plans, safety protocol and future management plan.
- b. The City of Quinte West is calling upon the Federal Government to provide a supplement to the allocations provided to municipalities under the Association of Municipalities of Ontario Canada Community-Building Funds agreement for 2024-2028 for the same amount that was allocated, effectively doubling the allocations for those years.
- c. The Township of Stirling-Rawdon is requesting that the province update the Public Sector Salary Disclosure Act to reflect the inflation rates since 1996 and further that the inflation rate is applied each year to the requirement to report public salaries.
