### **Background:**

The Community Services Department operates and maintains various facilities, parks, and trails in the Township throughout the calendar year.

### **Discussion/Analysis/Overview:**

#### Ripley Huron Community Center

The ice shed at the Ripley Huron Community Center has been painted by Miller's Rejuvenations. The walls of the shed were painted in an "American White" Sherwin Williams paint. The steel gussets that tie in the wood beams above the ice surface have been sanded and coated with epoxy. The gusset coating was a recommendation from an engineer inspection. This project was budgeted for 50,000\$ and came in at 44,000\$ plus HST. (pictures attached)

#### Victoria Park

A new accessible, concrete ramp was installed at Victoria Park in Lucknow. The ramp leads onto the tennis courts and was installed by Gary Moulton Construction. (picture attached)

#### Langdon and Lewis Park

An accessible swing will be replaced in Ripley's Lewis Park. The old swing was vandalized and not functioning properly. Cost for replacement is 2200\$ plus HST.

A musical keyboard was stolen from the Langdon playground in Point Clark. The playground component will be replaced, and tamperproof hardware added. Cost for replacement is 1200\$ plus HST.

**Financial Impacts:** Ice shed painting and Victoria Park were included in the 2024 capital budget. The Langdon and Lewis Park items will be incorporated into the 2024 operating budget.
