AND FURTHER agrees to enter into a five-year memorandum of understanding with the Bluewater Town and Country Snowmobile Club for the use of Township lands for the use of snowmobile trails;

AND FURTHER authorizes the appropriate by-law be brought forward to the next Council meeting.

Background:

Snowmobile clubs have used municipal road allowances and trails for many years during the winter season. The proposed agreement is an update from an existing agreement that expired earlier this year.

Discussion/Analysis/Overview:

The only change to the snowmobile trail route in the past five years is the trail that used to follow Sideroad 20 south of Bruce Rd 6 has been relocated to the west side of the Ripley-Huron Community Centre property. This was the result of the County of Bruce fully closing the culvert on Sideroad 20 to all forms of traffic.

Township staff have reviewed the proposal and we have no concerns. We are in the process of integrating the trail maps into our GIS mapping system so we can more easily identify the location of the trails within Township properties.
