# 1. Adoption of Minutes

### 4. Ripley Minor Baseball

- New player for Tball: A family moving to the area reached out via social media to join Tball. The secretary contact the family, but has not heard back. Tball ends August 8.
- WOBA Update

WOBA will take team records for the first 10 games to determine seeding for year end tournament.

Question brought forward from a parent: If there is a conflict with scheduling, are OBA players required to play in the WOBA Year End tournament or can they choose between WOBA and OBA? Response from Committee: WOBA does not required OBA players to play in the Year End tournament as long as they have their 7 games in.

Concern from U9 Coach: During a U9 game, the Ripley coach noticed a WOBA player on the Mildmay team, who was also seen playing for the Walkerton WOBA team the game prior. Darry will email WOBA to look into this and if Mildmay and Walkerton are using the same player.

Ripley Minor Baseball is very short on umpires. Committee members/coaches have expressed frustrations with some umpires being too quite, not making calls or being vocal enough to have the game under control. The younger/new umpires need support from veteran umpires, so they can build confidence.

### 5. Equipment

Will need 6 dozen 65cc for year end tournament and another two dozen incredi-balls. The secretary will order more balls. No quorum.

### 6. Ripley Minor Soccer

Blastball and U6 soccer will end July 29.

# 7. Baseball Day in Ripley

Overall the day went well. Due to insurance concerns, there was no dunk tank. The BBQ and balloon toss was successful. The BBQ needed more Committee Members to volunteer. Despite an estimated \$1600 profit at the BBQ, the expenses were more than the profit, totaling a -\$41. At a future meeting, the committee will vote on whether they want to continue with the Baseball Day in Ripley next year or not considering the loss in revenue and total volunteer hours put into the 10-hour day.

During the BBQ, the Ripley Lions Club came to wrap potatoes for their fundraising BBQ dinner the following day. Committee members asked them to come back another time because it was too busy/congested in the pavilion to have two organizations using the space.

# 9. U9 OBA Tournament

Initially, the WOBA U9 Year End Tournament was to be shared between Ripley and Port Elgin. Port Elgin has announced they will not be able to support the tournament anymore.

There are 22 teams expected for the tournament. Ripley Minor Baseball cannot support a tournament for that many teams. Darryl will reach out to Kincardine, asking if they would host 6 teams. There is possibility of using Lucknow ball diamonds and pitching machine.

Darryl will be convenor for the tournament.

The U9 parents are expected to help with the BBQ and take a shift as a game starter. Leeah will reach out to U9 parents with their BBQ shift/game starter shift. Darryl will provide Leeah with the schedule and help her assign game starters.

To avoid the last-minute planning as in previous years, Darryl will provide a schedule for the tournament and will plug in team names once WOBA provides them.

3 air compressors are needed for the 3 diamonds to keep the pitching machine tires inflated.

Reid's Corners will need a jerry can and generator for the pitching machine.

Provide a cooler and water for umpires and game starters at all 3 diamonds.

A Shade Tent will be needed for Reid's Corners.

The Umpire in Chief will be given notice of the tournament and start scheduling umpires.
