Background:

A six-inch insulated steel Brine Pipe was leaking slowly, and rate of leak has increased to the point that a catastrophic failure could be imminent.

Discussion/Analysis/Overview:

The result would be losing the ice, and all associated ice rentals for a week or more. Staff are preparing to repair with Drennan Refrigeration and plan a one-day ice plant shut down and repair during colder temperatures and avoid any disruption in service / rentals. The Emergency Purchases form has been completed and approved by the CAO in accordance with Section 7.0 of the Township's Purchasing and Procurement Policy. The funds will be included in the 2025 capital budget. We bring this forward for information purchases.
