AND FURTHER authorizes the sale of the Pumper.

### **Background:**

The Township of Huron-Kinloss has in effect a Surplus Equipment policy that allows council to authorize the sale of surplus equipment in accordance with the policy direction.

### **Discussion/Analysis/Overview:**

In accordance with the NFPA standard of 15-years for frontline apparatus, the 2008 E one Typhoon Ripley pumper has been replaced. As the new apparatus is now inservice, we are looking to surplus the apparatus 2008 E one Typhoon while it remains in good condition. As it is still MTO certified for 2025, it is ready for immediate use and has value as a back-up pumper for any fire department or emergency services organization or for a commercial or agricultural application.

Following surplus Equipment Policy valued over \$500.00, sale of apparatus will be made through Govdeals.
