John,

Good morning John, I am writing you on behalf of the Grounds committee for Lucknow's Music in the Fields. First of all, I would like to thank the township and it's employees for the continuing support they have provided to us. As a volunteer committee this help is vital for us to continue to raise funds for our community.

Our ask of council and township's employees is similar to other years.

We request the approval to temporarily restrict traffic to Walter St. and Washington St. during the Music in the Fields event from Aug 21-24, 2025. All emergency services will be notified. Residents will be given "special passes" to allow them access with no questions.

We request the use of one of the township's portable generators. This is used to provide power to our backstage trailers. We are currently working with Westario Power to secure permanent power but this may not be possible for this year.

We request the support of our Roads department for the following: Possible grading and dust control of the Walter St. extension, camping entrance and stage location on the Graceland property. This will be dependent on site/weather conditions prior to our event.

4 dump trucks to be staged  
on site by Fri morning Aug 25th.

A qualified driver to check  
the trucks Fri and Sat afternoon and empty if deemed necessary. This has historically been done by an employee that is at our event.

Qualified drivers for each  
truck on Sunday morning by 10 am to allow for efficient and quick cleanup of the site by our local school students and volunteer groups.

Waive all tipping fees at the  
township landfill.

Waive all building permit  
fees that may be incurred due to the size of some of our on site tents. All tents are erected by Mildmay Tent Rentals. All tents have engineered drawings.

Support with Field Staff wrt  
barriers, dust control etc the week leading up to the event. Jason has been a very big help to

us every year. We are very grateful for his and the staff's help.

Support if needed the week following the event in case large material needs to be removed. Historically this may include something like mattresses/tables that were deemed to large to load on Sunday.
