Being a By-law to Appoint Jake Vanderkolk as a Landfill Worker for the  
Township of Huron-Kinloss

---

**WHEREAS** Section 8(1) and 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provide that the powers of a municipality under this or any other Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues and has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purposes of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

**WHEREAS** a vacancy has occurred in the position of Public Works Operator;

**WHEREAS** The Council for The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss deems it expedient to appoint a Public Works Operator for the Township of Huron-Kinloss;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss enacts as follows:

1. That By-law No. 2013-89 and By-law No. 2025-15 are hereby repealed.
2. That the Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss Council hereby appoints Jake Vanderkolk as a Public Works Operator for the Township of Huron-Kinloss effective June 16, 2025.
3. This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon final passage.
4. This By-law may be cited as the "Appoint Vanderkolk as Public Works Operator By-Law"

**READ a FIRST and SECOND TIME** this 16<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2025.

**READ a THIRD TIME and FINALLY PASSED** this 16<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2025.
