- Cancer prevention fire gear washers are now fully operational at both fire stations. Training on their proper use is scheduled for July.
- Additionally, we conducted two training sessions with the new recruits, covering several important topics and providing an introduction to their new fire station team members.
- Students from Lucknow School visited the fire station for a tour and a fire safety education session. The visit focused on the importance of smoke alarms, having two ways out of the home, and establishing a family meeting place in case of a home emergency. We also encouraged students to remind their parents to test their smoke alarms monthly to ensure they are working properly.
