**BY-LAW No.  
2026 - 27**

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Being a By-Law to Dedicate Blocks J and K Plan 3M49  
(Part 10 & 11 3R-10474) as Public Highway

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**WHEREAS** Section 8(1) and 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provide that the powers of a municipality under this or any other Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues and has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purposes of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 26 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended sets out what constitutes a highway for all municipalities in Ontario;

**AND WHEREAS** Block J and K were set out as on-foot reserves at the time of registration of Plan M49;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss deems it advisable as outlined in Report BLD-2026-13, to dedicate the one-foot reserves known as Blocks J and K Plan 49 (McTavish Subdivision) in the Township of Huron-Kinloss as public highway;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss **ENACTS** as follows;

1. That the lands described as Blocks J and K Plan M49 (Part 10 & 11 3R-10474) are hereby dedicated as part of the public highway known as McTavish Crescent.
2. That this by-law shall come into full force and effect upon its final passage.
3. That this by-law may be cited as the "Road Dedication – Blocks J and K Plan M49 (McTavish Crescent) By-law".

**READ a FIRST and SECOND TIME** this 13<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2026.

**READ a THIRD TIME and FINALLY PASSED** this 13<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2026.
