Background:

The Community Services Department plans and implements programming and events throughout the calendar year including the Winter Carnival, Summer Sports, including minor baseball and soccer, the Wolf Cub Adventure Camp and the Ripley Food Art Craft Festival.

Discussion:

Planning and registration are underway for the annual Winter Carnival, Ripley Summer Sports, including soccer and baseball, as well as the Wolf Cub Adventure Camp and the Ripley Food Art Craft Festival.

Winter Carnival

The Winter Carnival will look different this year as we are unable to offer the breakfast, ice painting and sleigh rides, however new events that promote family friendly activities and physical distancing are in place. This year's Winter Carnival will be celebrated on Saturday, February 13th and include a Snow/Yard Sculpture contest, a Scavenger Hunt and a DIY Outdoor Rink Contest. A special thank you to this year's sponsors for working with us on the Snow Sculpture Contest and DIY Outdoor Rink Contest: RVilla, Huron Shores Lion's Club, Lucknow & District Chamber of Commerce, Lucknow Lancers & Ripley Wolves. If the Community Centre is permitted to open in the near future, the plan is to run the ice painting event at a later date.

Programming

The Summer Sports Committee met on Tuesday, January 19th to discuss and finalize plans for the 2021 season, registration, and fees. Online registration will open the beginning of February, with a deadline set for the end of March.

The Wolf Cub Adventure Camp is set to run all 4 weeks in the month of July. Staff have begun to plan and prepare for many possible scenarios including implementing extra protocols, procedures, and camp cohorts, depending on current provincial restrictions in place at the time.

Ripley Food Art Craft Festival

The Ripley Food Art Craft Festival is scheduled for Saturday, August 21st at the Ripley-Huron Community Centre. Registration for the festival will begin in February and staff have begun to plan and prepare for many possible scenarios including hosting the festival as per usual on the arena floor, outside under a tent, or online if necessary.
